**OWNERS MANUAL
GREEN&MEAN OVERDRIVE**

Thank you for purchasing the GREEN&MEAN OVERDRIVE.

Please read this manual carefully before you using and playing with the GREEN&MEAN OVERDRIVE.

Remove the four screws on the back of the pedal and insert a 9-Volt battery block or use a 9 volt DC negative tip power supply (Ibanez® or similar). When you do not use the pedal for a long time, always remove the battery. If you use the pedal with a power supply but with connected battery, be careful it could be that in a certain time the unused battery leaks.

The GREEN&MEAN OVERDRIVE has to be powered with a 9-volt DC negative tip power supply (Ibanez® or similar) or with a 9 volt battery (both are not included). This pedal has a high power consumption and the use of a power supply (not included) is recommended.

Plugging into the input jack turns on the power. If you use a battery unplug the input jack when the pedal is not used. This disconnects the battery and extends battery life.

IMPORTANT:

Always unplug the input jack when you change the battery.

The GREEN&MEAN OVERDRIVE is a negative ground pedal. Therefore never share (daisy chain) a power supply with vintage style pedals (positive ground) - you will damage the power supply and your pedals.

- **Do not use or store the pedal under moisture conditions.**
- **Do not store or use the pedal in hot or cold areas and do avoid rough handling.**
- **Do not use chemicals to clean the pedal, for cleaning use a soft cloth or a soft brush .**
- **Be careful. Keep it away from children.**

CAUTION:

Always turn the Vol. knob down (counter clockwise) before you use the pedal, that you do not damage your ears, amplifier or your speakers.

The GREEN&MEAN OVERDRIVE produces a transparent smooth vintage overdrive sound and is powered with the famous Texas Instruments RC4558. (If you wish, we can use a JRC4558)

We use Poly Film Caps, Silver Micas, to give you that transparent Texas Blues tone.

The 3-way switch let you select:

Classic: early 1980 Screamer

Mean: a little more gain and bass

Bass: same gain as in classic but with all the bass flow thru
